Program Description:

Heritage Southwest ISD is actively recruiting qualified staff for state and federal funding involving children in Cass County who are three- and four-years-old by September 1.

Michigan is offering the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) for four-year-old children and Strong Beginnings pilot preschool program for three-year-old children with factors that may place them at risk for low educational attainment. These programs are based on research that shows similar children, who attend a high-quality preschool for one and two years prior to kindergarten have significant positive developmental outcomes when compared to their peers who attended no quality program. Both GSRP and Strong Beginnings feature a unique family engagement component that includes a Family Liaison as part of the team.

Essential Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Demonstrated knowledge of the high quality, early childhood educational programs
- Ability to develop effective, nurturing relationships with children, staff and the school community
- Demonstrated knowledge of: child development, early childhood education and special education
- Demonstrated knowledge of: family systems, trauma and poverty issues
- Understanding of and ability to promote developmentally appropriate practice in the classroom
- Well-developed observation techniques
- Demonstrated ability to communicate well, both orally and in writing
- Demonstrated professionalism and ethical decision-making in working with others
- Demonstrated organizational abilities
- Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit on the floor
