Lewis Cass Intermediate School District Superintendent Search Press Release February 24, 2021

The Lewis Cass Intermediate School District Board of Education continues to move forward with the process of selecting a new Superintendent of Schools. Seventeen educators submitted applications for the position. Applicants consisted of current superintendents, central office administrators, principals and individuals with non-traditional backgrounds. Although most applicants are from Michigan, the position attracted interest from Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas and Ohio. The Board completed a thorough review of the applications and has invited four educators to be interviewed.

The interviews will be held on March 1. A Zoom connection will be available on the district's website for public attendance.

Board President, Kevin Anderson stated, "We were pleased with the applicant pool and interest demonstrated in our ISD. We believe there are quality candidates that may meet our needs and expectations. We look forward to finding out more about the candidates' leadership abilities and what each candidate has to offer our students, staff and communities. It is our hope to have a new superintendent in place by the beginning of the July."

The superintendent search became necessary when Brent Holcomb announced his retirement as of July 1, 2021. The process has been facilitated by the Michigan Leadership Institute.
